If they do not have it, they have to apply their national chess federation for it.

**Fees for rating of the tournament results for ELO** in A, B, C, D, 30+, J (2,5 EUR per player), G1, G2, G3, I, Q1, Q2, Q3 (0,5 EUR per player) and E (10,5 EUR for a team) charged according to the economic directive of the Chess Federation of the Czech Republic, **are not included in the starting fee and will be paid by participants during the registration.** The organizer pays these fees for players with GM, IM, WGM and WIM titles, the same as for teams composed only of players with these titles.

**Late registrations:** Those players (or teams) whose application will be registered after 15<sup>th</sup> of June 2019 will pay additional charge of 12,5 EUR in A tournament, 8,5 EUR in B, C, D, 30+, E tournaments and 2,0 EUR in G1, G2, G3, H, J, K tournaments.
